

## Are you Eligible for MRP?

- Damaged residence must be located within Columbia city limits.
- Applicants must have registered with FEMA and had their residence designated as having sustained Minor damages.
- Primary residence sustained minor damages not to exceed \$25,000.
- Applicants must have owned and occupied the damaged property as their primary residence during October 2015 Flood.
- Damaged residence must be a single-unit structure, duplex, townhome, or condominium.
- Applicants must be considered Low to Moderate Income (below 80% AMI) at application intake.

## Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Disaster Recovery Program

## Minor Repair Program

**June 2017**

**Funding Available: \$3,398,680**  
**September 2017 – December 2021**

The City of Columbia is launching its Minor Repair Program (MRP) to assist low-to-moderate income (LMI) owner-occupied households that sustained Minor damages during the October 2015 Flood and have remaining repair needs not covered by the FEMA Individual Assistance Program and Small Business Association.

Funding up to \$25,000 will address rain/flood damages as well as lead based paint, asbestos, and other repairs necessary to bring dwellings up to the Columbia Property Maintenance Code and ensure that these housing units are more resilient to future natural hazards.



## Identification and Required Documents

*(one of the following for every household member)*

- State Issued ID
- Driver's License
- Passport
- Military ID
- Birth Certificate or current Immunization Record.

## Proof of Income

*(one for each household member over the age of 18)*

- 3 Consecutive Months Most Recent Paystubs
- 6 Months of Bank Statements
- Unemployment Statement
- Current Social Security or Veterans Benefit Letter
- Current Pension/Annuity Letter

## Proof of Ownership and Primary Residency

*(one of the following)*

- Deed Simple
- Mortgage Payment Book
- 2015 Real Property Insurance Policy
- 2015 Property Tax Receipts or Tax Bill
- Utility Bill for period covering October 2015
- Voter Registration Card

## Types of Improvements

Rehabilitation or reconstruction work may include the following types of improvements:

- Roof repair/replacement
- Flooring repair/replacement
- Electrical repair/replacement
- Window repair/replacement
- Electrical and plumbing fixtures
- Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC) equipment
- Appliance replacement
- Lead-based paint, asbestos, and mold remediation
- Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessibility
- Insulation and sheetrock repair/replacement
- Building foundation repair/replacement
- Repair/replacement unsafe water and sewer supplies
- Drainage improvements
