Description of Change: Request change in Agreement for Engineering Services between the City of Columbia (City) and Kleinschmidt Associates (Engineer) dated September 6, 2016 (Agreement).

Page 7, Section L, Subsection 1, item b). First sentence. Replace the words "Fee Schedule" with "COMPENSATION section above"

Revised sentence will read as follows: The COMPENSATION section above specifies the amount presently allocated by the City for items and services to be provided during the period of performance.

Page 12, Section N, Subsection 7. Replace subsection 7 with the following:

"The Engineer will include the portion of the sentence immediately preceding paragraph (1) and the provisions of paragraphs (1) through (7) in every subcontract or purchase order unless exempted by rules, regulations, or orders of the Secretary of Labor issued pursuant to section 204 of Executive Order 11246 of September 24, 1965, so that such provisions will be binding upon each subcontractor or vendor. The Engineer will take such action with respect to any subcontract or purchase order as the administering agency may direct as a means of enforcing such provisions, including sanctions for noncompliance: Provided, however, that in the event an Engineer becomes involved in, or is threatened with, litigation with a subcontractor or vendor as a result of such direction by the administering agency the Engineer may request the United States to enter into such litigation to protect the interests of the United States."

Page 20, Section HH, Subsection 6, item b), last sentence. Replace "A" with "C". Revised sentence will read as follows:

The Engineer and their successors, transferees, assignees and subcontractors (In accordance with Section U., Ownership of Project Documents, herein) acknowledge and agree to comply with applicable provisions governing department and FEMA access to records, accounts, documents, information, facilities and staff (per Department of Homeland Security standards terms and conditions, v. 3.0 ¶ XXVI. (2013) and (in accordance with Section C., Access to Records, herein.

All other provisions of the Agreement, except as herein modified or changed, remain in full force and effect.


