



**AMENDMENT NUMBER TWO TO THE
AGREEMENT BETWEEN CITY OF COLUMBIA AND THE SAINT BERNARD PROJECT,
INC., dba SBP, Inc.
FOR
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT-DISASTER RECOVERY (CDBG-DR)
HOUSING REHABILITATION AND RECONSTRUCTION PROGRAM**

THIS AMENDMENT is entered into as of the date last signed between the City of Columbia, South Carolina (the "City") and The St. Bernard Project, Inc., dba SBP, Inc.

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Public Law 114-113 (12/18/2015) and Public Law 115-31; The Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2016 and the Federal Register Notice 82 FR 36812, August 07, 2017 and 81 FR 39687, June 07, 2016 at DR-4241 that allocated CDBG-DR funds awarded to the City of Columbia, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") has awarded \$26,155,000 in Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) funds to the City for activities authorized under title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (42 U.S.C. 5301 et seq.) and described in the City's Action Plan (the "Action Plan"); and

WHEREAS, the City and SBP entered into an agreement on December 1, 2020 to carry out a part of the City's Federal award by committing \$8.9 million dollars of the City's Federal award, pursuant to this Subrecipient Agreement between the City and SBP (the "Agreement" or "SRA") and amended the original agreement on October 4, 2021 via Amendment One; and,

WHEREAS, the City and SBP now wish to implement Amendment Two in order to clarify items within the Scope of Work.

WHEREAS, no other terms of the original agreement dated December 1, 2020 or Amendment One dated October 4th, 2021 are affected by this amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, for valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Parties agree as follows:

III. Scope of Work, Part A Eligible Use of Funds, second paragraph shall be amended to include the following sentence:

Notwithstanding any applicable City of Columbia procurement regulations requiring the Department of Procurement and Contracts to handle purchases up to this threshold, SBP may procure services and execute contracts not to exceed \$5M under provisions of this SRA with guidance by the Department, if necessary.

Section H shall be amended to replace the full paragraph with the following paragraph:
